Reading—reviewed purchasing Collections for grades 7-8; this textbook is published by HMH, the same publishers of the K-6 reading series Journeys. This allows for common language and consistency. We will discuss at the next Board meeting.

Programming—we reviewed the vision to provide more electives, higher level courses, general courses and a “tracking” program (MAP-Millville’s Advancement Plan) in order to meet the needs of all students. Senate Bill 880 postpones using Keystones as a graduation requirement until the class of 2019. This does not remove remediation obligations for the district. Conversation continued about how this would occur. Specifics concerning courses and staffing were explored—adding additional AP classes, adding additional staff to offer new program MAPs, STEM at both buildings and how it would look, and more electives.
