The preschool serves local 3 - 4 year olds learning emergent language and literacy skills, basic letter word and number recognition, writing, logic and problem solving, and learning personal and social skills through play. The Lisbon Exempted Village School District Preschool has maintained a **5 Star Quality Rating** from the Ohio Departments of Education and Job and Family Services.
