**Extended Instructional Programs**

The Superintendent may establish and implement the following programs in accordance with state law and the District’s educational philosophy:

1. Nursery schools for children between the ages of 2 and 6 years.
2. Before and after-school programs for students in grades K-6.
3. Child care and training center for pre-school children and for students whose parents work.
4. Model day care program in cooperation with the State Board of Education.
5. Tutorial program.
6. Adult education program.
7. Pre-apprenticeship programs.
8. Outdoor education program.
9. Summer school, whether for credit or not.
10. Independent study, whether for credit or not.
11. Support services and instruction for students who are, or whose parents/guardians are, chemically dependent.
12. Anti-bias education and activities to address intergroup conflict resolution.
13. Volunteer service credit program.
14. Vocational Academy.
15. Advanced vocational training and/or career education program.
16. Credit Recovery Program(s).
