TITLE: Physical Education Teacher - OHS

LOCATION/DEPARTMENT: Otsego High School

POSITION SUMMARY: All employees of the Otsego Public Schools, including Physical Education Teachers, are expected to display a positive, caring, nurturing attitude and a genuine desire to assist all students and staff when necessary to maintain a safe and orderly environment.

Physical Education Teachers instruct students about sports, physical development, health, and proper nutrition, and have knowledge of sports and the health sciences. Physical education teachers show students not only how to play various sports, but also how physical activity benefits the muscles and overall health.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan lessons and organize activities to meet class objectives.
- Gather the appropriate materials and equipment to address the goals and objectives.
- Assist in maintaining gym and weight room equipment.
- Employ a variety of instructional techniques and resources consistent with parameters of the educational environment and the needs and limitations of the students involved.
- Assess and document the students' growth and provide progress reports as required.
- Strive to maintain and improve professional competence.
- Identify and utilize available district and community resources for educational purposes when appropriate.
- Maintain a positive working relationship with parents, administrators, peers and the community.
- Deliver instruction both indoors and outdoors
- Teach students how to play various sports and how to exercise.
- Works with athletic director and varsity coaches to improve and enhance athletic programs.
- Other duties as assigned by the Building Principal.

From time to time, in emergency situations, it becomes necessary for all adults, including Physical Education Teachers, to assist in supervising groups of students and attending to the physical needs of students.
