

- Undivided subdivisions








### Elementary Boundaries: Starting 2023-24






# Elementary Populations After Redistricting



## Impact

- Elementary students changing schools is a little over 1,000 or approximately 35%.
- Middle school students changing schools is a little over 900 or approximately 45%.
