

# Grading at Crawfordsville High School

## **Q1= Quarter 1/End of the first 9 weeks**

This grade is the total grade of the first 9 weeks of the school year. It does not change. This grade is equal to 40% of the semester grade.

## **Q2= Quarter 2/End of the second 9 weeks**

This grade is the total grade of the second 9 weeks of the school year. It does not change. This grade is equal to 40% of the semester grade.

## **E1: Semester 1 Exam**

This is the final exam grade for each course at the end of first semester. It is 20% of the semester grade.

## **S1: Semester 1 Grade**

This is the only grade that goes on the student's transcript. It is used to determine if they passed the course and earned the credit to be applied toward their graduation progress. This is what is used to calculate GPA.

**Q3, Q4, E2, and S2 work the same way, but for Semester 2.**

CHS uses a 4.0 grading scale to compute GPA and class rank which is calculated at the end of each semester. Students who are in AP classes are on a 4.0 weighted grading scale. Students who are in a yearlong AP class **MUST** complete the entire year in order to receive the weighted grade. If a student drops an AP class after the 1<sup>st</sup> semester then that 1<sup>st</sup> semester grade will not be weighted.
