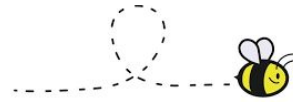

SENIORS: “Ms. Gwen, what should I be doing right now?!” Start your senior year strong. Stay on top of your classes as well as important deadlines. Every school still has virtual information sessions and visit options on their website. Sign up for those!

Fall Deadlines:

- ALL UC & CSU applications need to be submitted by November 30th - No Exceptions!
- [FAFSA](#) (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) opens on October 1st for seniors. Students will be submitting an application for the 2023-24 school year. Parents will be using your 2021 tax returns to fill out the financial portion of this application. The deadline for submission is March 2nd but I recommend submitting your FAFSA in the fall if possible. More money is available.

College Applications:

If you have a 3.0 GPA or above you are eligible to apply to a UC. The [UC Application](#) is now open. You can begin working on it.

If you have a 2.4 GPA or above, you are eligible to apply to a CSU. The [CSU application](#) does not open until October 1st. You have time to do your research about the different CSU campuses

[Common Application](#) is used to apply to Private colleges & Out-of-State universities. Deadlines vary. Do your research about about out-of-state schools that offer tuition discounts to CA students, e.g. [Western Undergraduate Exchange Schools \(WUE\)](#). FYI - University of AZ give merit aid, not WUE discounts.

Planning to attend Community College after graduation? Enrollment for **CA Community Colleges** will open in April 2023.

WORK PERMITS: First thing you need to do is get a job.

Download the attached [work permit](#) form OR pick up a copy in the CCC

- 1) Fill in the "Minor's Information"(your name and information)
- 2) Have your employer fill out the employer information and sign it.
- 3) Have one of your parents or your legal guardian sign it.
- 4) Bring your signed permit to the CCC (E building across from The Pit) Rm. E-128. I will process it and have a signed "official" copy ready for you to pick up.
- 5) Return the signed permit to your employer for their records

What about Standardized Testing?? Should a senior try and take an SAT or ACT this fall?

- **NO!!!** Do not register out-of-state for testing! The Boston University rep told students yesterday, "You don't need to have a score." Reps are hearing about how difficult it is in CA to get a seat at a test center.
- Who requires testing? MIT, US Military Academies & International Universities
- This is what the [UC website](#) says about testing. Same for the CSUs.
- Test Optional means that a student can submit scores if they have them and they think it will add value to their application. Many private colleges and out-of-state schools are test optional this year.

How do I search for scholarships?

- Sign up for 1-2 scholarship databases. You can create a profile and give them information that will "supposedly" help them find scholarships where you match the eligibility requirements. Here are a few that I recommend:

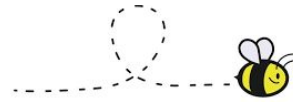
Are there only scholarships for seniors? No, but you will see more scholarships for seniors. The scholarship databases can help you find scholarships for 10th & 11th graders.

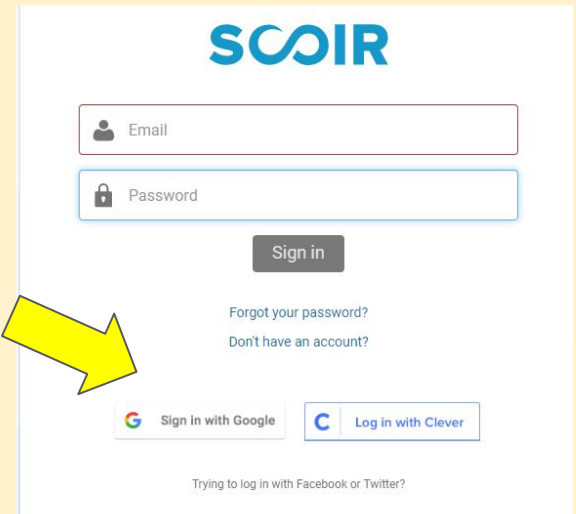

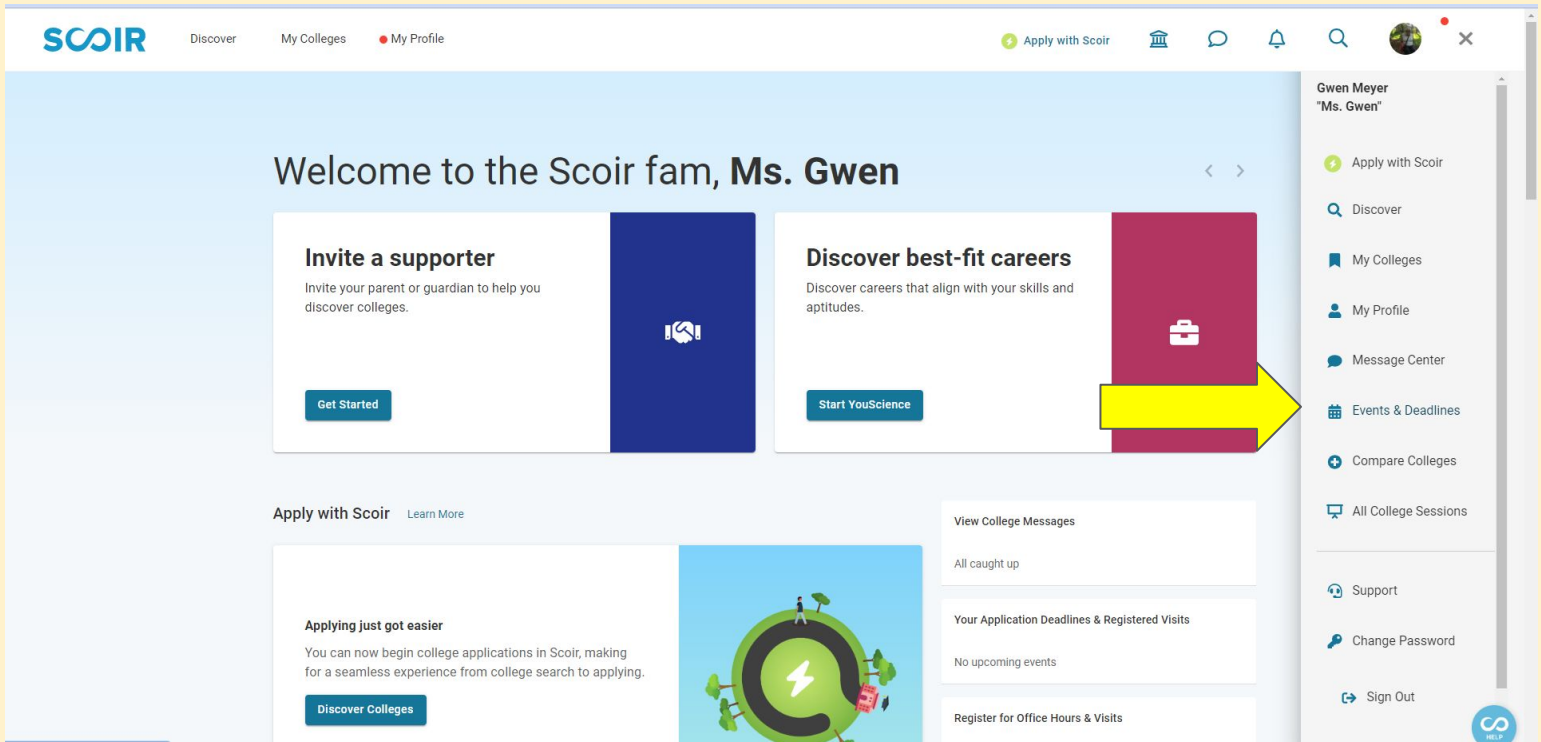
Scoir - pronounced "Score"
