Online Learning Guiding Change Framework

Current Reality

- Supplemental courses up to 50% allowed
- 279Online full time online option
- Partnership with NSO for supplemental online
- Many Osseo courses approved for supplemental online (everything in the 279Online course catalog and additional district wide).

Acceptable Means

- Must have agreement with EMO
- Must be within the bounds of state statute
- Must be in bounds of employee contracts/ MOU's
- Must be in bounds of School Board Policy
- Must take into consideration the impact of race and culture

Results

- An online program that creates opportunity and flexibility for students attending Osseo Area Schools.
- Ability for student to attend full time (comprehensive) online
- Ability for students to access supplemental online courses
- This program would utilize best practices in online learning and engage students in meaningful interactive ways that incorporates project based learning
- Access to a content area instructional staff to facilitate direct learning and support for students

Online Programming Timeline

Phase 1 2020-21

- Development of K-12 comprehensive programming.
- MDE Certification Process for comprehensive online learning

Phase 2 2021-22

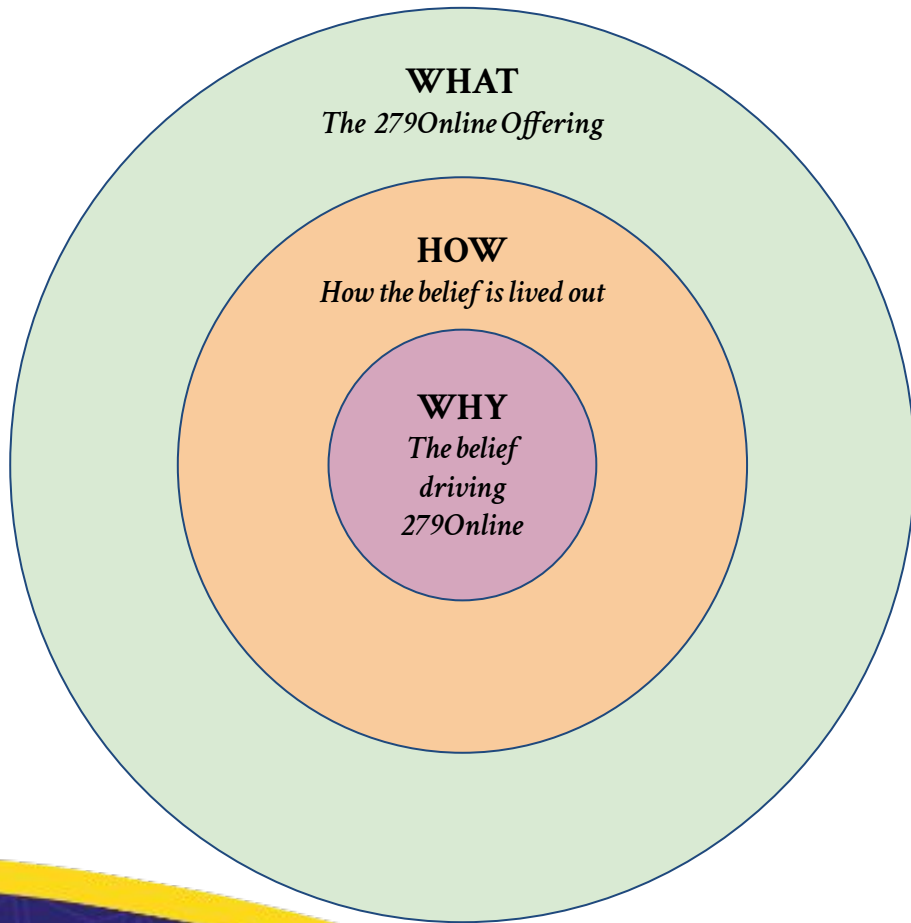
- Year 1 implementation of K-12 comprehensive Online programming

Phase 3 2022-23

- Year 2 implementation of K-12 comprehensive Online program
- Continued marketing planning/ implementation
- Development of 9-12 supplemental online programming
- MDE certification process for supplemental online learning

Phase 4 2023-24

- Year 3 implementation of K-12 comprehensive online programming
- Year 1 implementation of 9-12 supplemental online programming

Phase 3: Supplemental Guiding Change Framework

Current Reality

- State Statute allows any student to access supplemental courses for up to 50% of their course work
- 279Online is currently full time online option
- We have an existing partnership with NSO for supplemental online
- We have an MOU for online learning teachers through Osseo Excel
- 26 Formal Osseo Online Courses are already approved for supplemental online that any current high school could provide

Acceptable Means

- Must have agreement with EMO for any structures that are non-traditional
- Must be within the bounds of state statute
- Must be in bounds of employee contracts/ MOU's
- Must be in bounds of School Board Policy
- Must take into consideration the impact of race and culture in the design process
- Must follow the existing online program registration process through counselors for the 23-24 school year

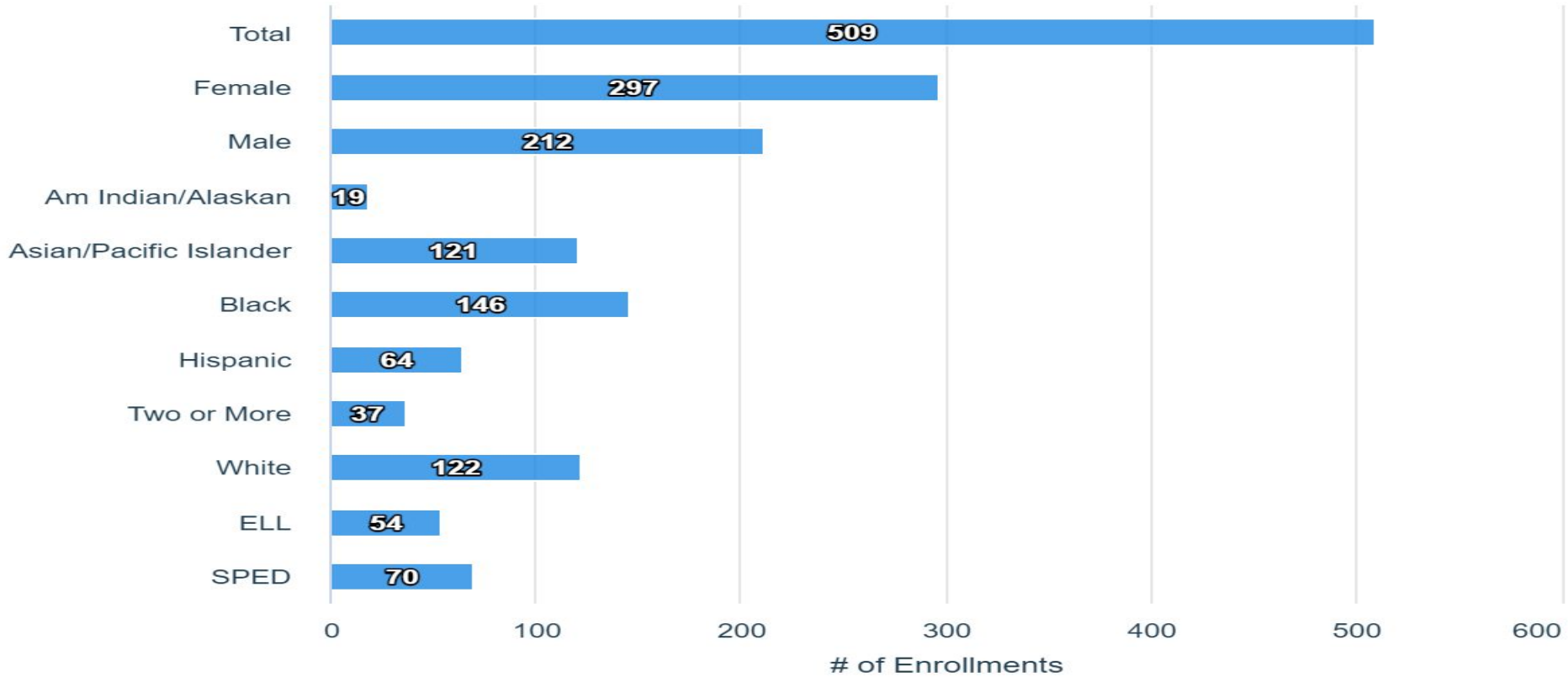
Results

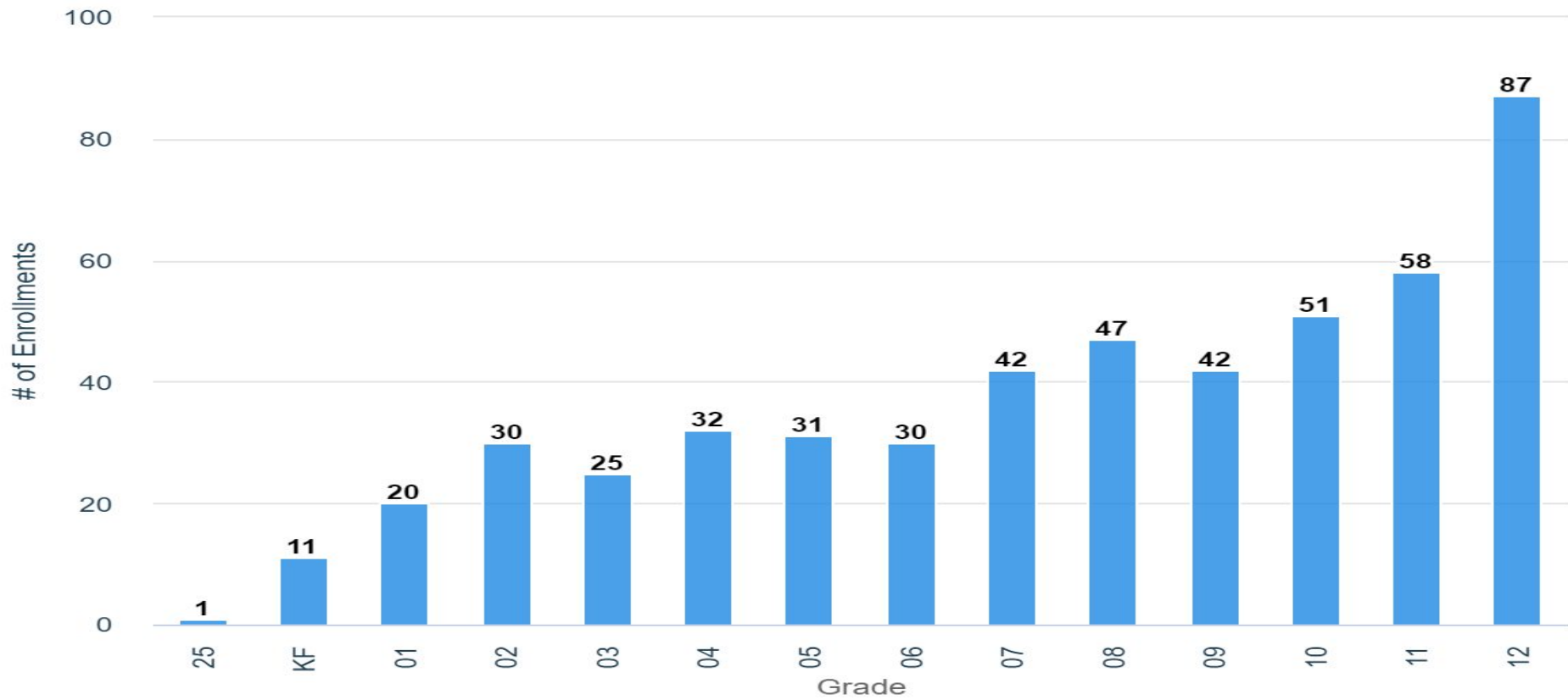
- A supplemental online program that creates opportunity and flexibility for students attending Osseo Area Schools.
- Ability for students in grade 9-12 to access supplemental online courses within ISD279 that are already approved or that are currently being accessed by ISD 279 students from other providers (NSO, Mnka Online, EP Online, etc.)
- This program would utilize best practices in online learning and engage students in meaningful interactive ways that incorporates project based learning
- Dedicated content area instructional staff to facilitate learning and support for students within content courses.

23-24 School Year

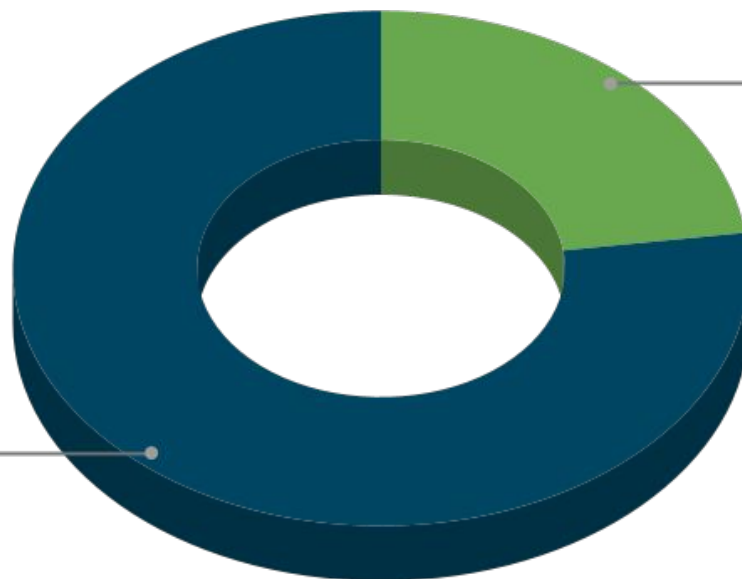
Supplemental Programming:
