SCHS recently completed SAT testing on March 1st. The SAT is now the state mandated test for high schools and all juniors are required to take the test. The day went very well and I am very thankful for the efforts of our school test coordinator, Mrs. Losey and the rest of our staff.

Next year, we will begin an extensive SAT Prep program that will be implemented for students in grades 9-11. All freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will take a version of the PSAT test in the fall. We will work on SAT practice during FLEX and in our classes. Students will all have a College Board account and their scores will generate lessons to do on Khan Academy. Students may work independently on Khan academy anytime.
