Austin shared a MAP update: MAP incentive program for kids who maintained proficiency and made growth. ECE teachers have done focus groups with "bubble" kids (48 kids). 44 of them grew by at least five points. Austin can't pull the final report until the end of the testing window, but initial info looks promising.

CSIP:

Austin reviewed goals for CSIP--reading, math and ODW. Achievement Gap goal relates to the TSI status. We need to increase reading proficiency of students with disabilities from 9% to 24%.
