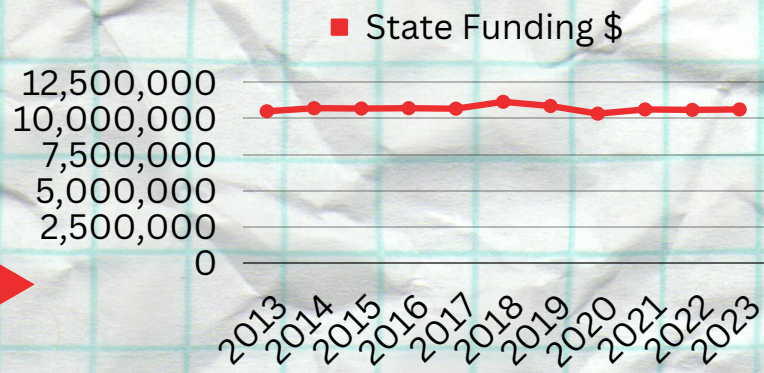

State funding has increased 0.1% over 10 years.



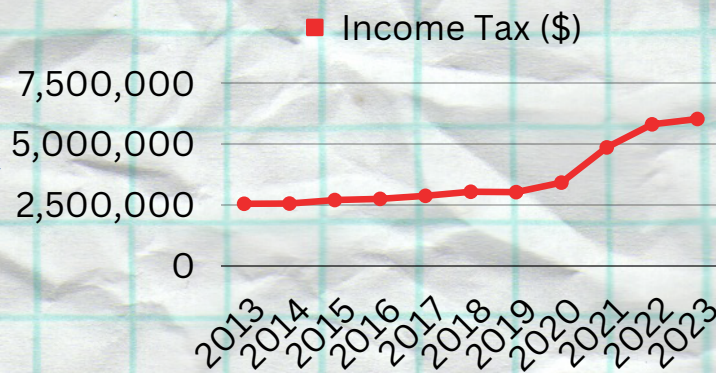
Local RLSD property tax receipts have increased 1% over 10 years.

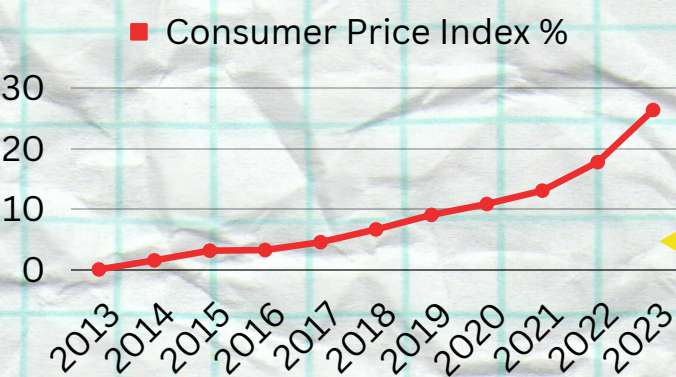
PROPERTY TAX (LOCAL)

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX

- The State of Ohio deems Ross a "wealthy" community. Therefore, Ohio says the community should fund a larger share of its school district.
- RLSD received \$10.46 million in state funding in 2013. RLSD is projected to receive \$10.59 million in state funding in 2023.
- Over the last 10 years, the cost of consumer goods (Consumer Price Index) has risen exponentially and health care costs are rising even faster.
