

VOTER INFORMATION

QUALIFICATION OF VOTERS

In order to vote, you must:

- Be a United States citizen
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a district resident for at least 30 days prior to the vote date
- Eligible voters include those who have voted in federal, state, county, or school district elections within the past four years, those who have registered with the Nassau County Board of Elections, and residents who registered during the school district's registration period
- Must register no later than May 1, 2018 in order to be eligible to vote at our May 15, 2018 Budget and Trustee election

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

If a voter wishes to vote with an Absentee Ballot, he/she must complete an application for an Absentee Ballot and submit the application to Ida Johnson, District Clerk, who will then provide the Absentee Ballot. The application must be received at least seven (7) days (May 8th) before the election if the Absentee Ballot is to be mailed to the voter. Persons designated by the Nassau County Board of Elections as "permanently disabled" pursuant to the provision of the Election Law, will automatically receive an absentee ballot. Absentee Ballots must be filed with Ida Johnson, District Clerk, no later than 5:00pm election day (May 15, 2018). Anything after 5:00pm will not be valid.
