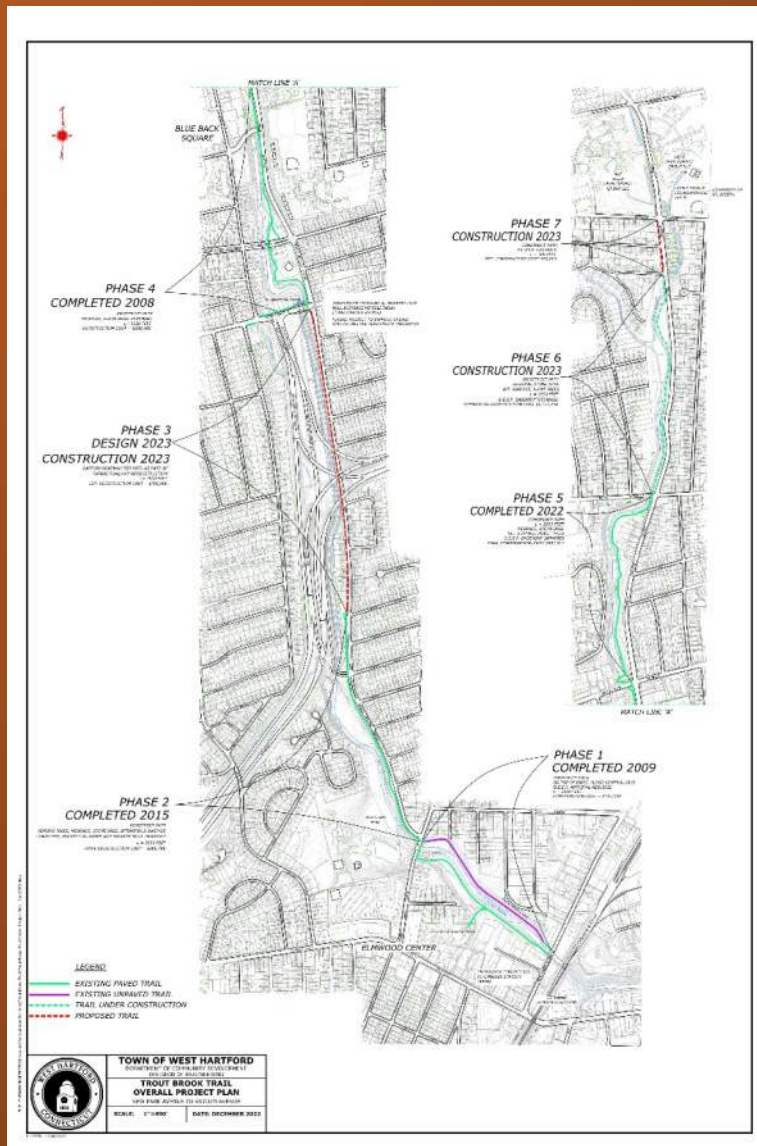

# Trout Brook Trail



## Overall Concept Plan

- Multi-use linear park featuring 8'-10' wide paved trail
- Approx. 4 miles long when completed
- Phases 1 , 2, 4, & 5 completed
- Phase 3 in design
- Phase 7 to follow Phase 6

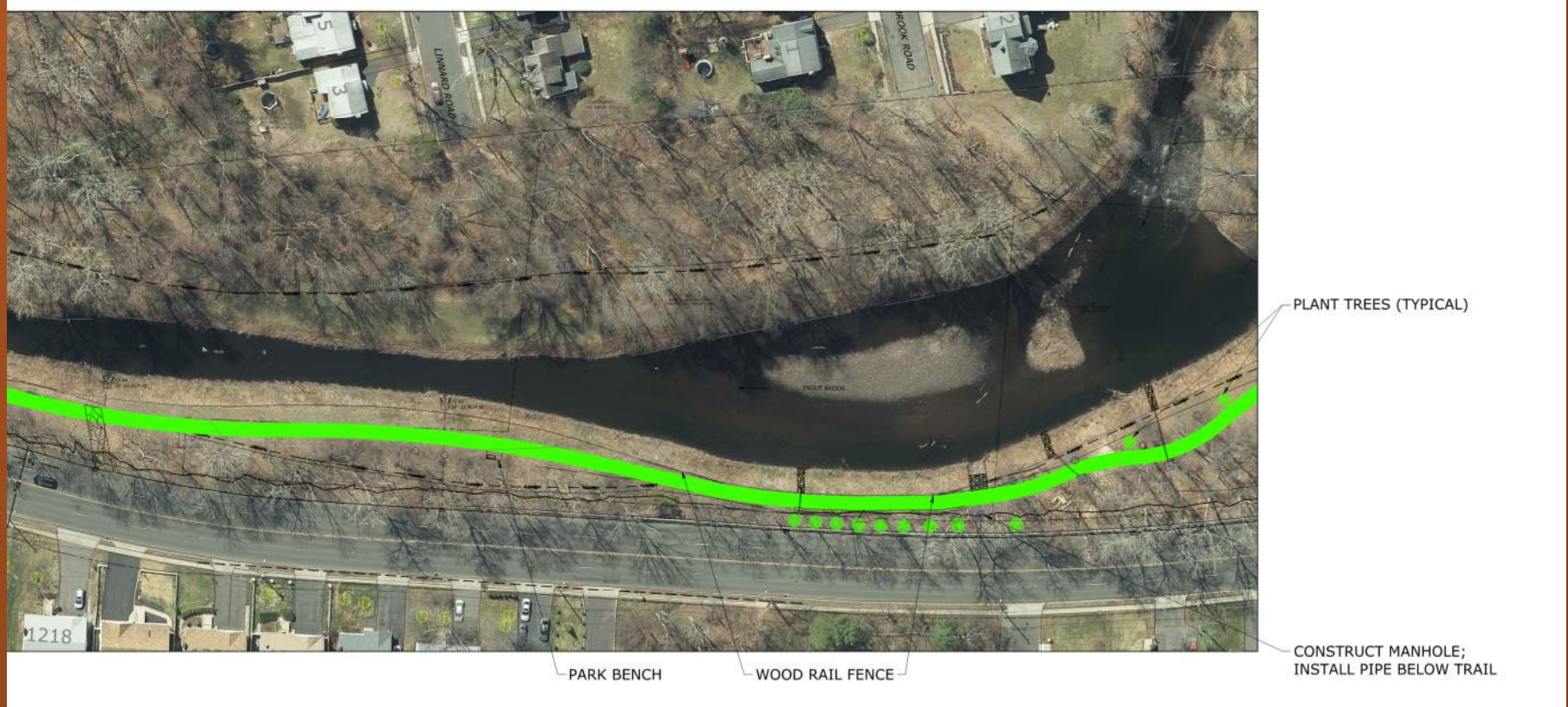

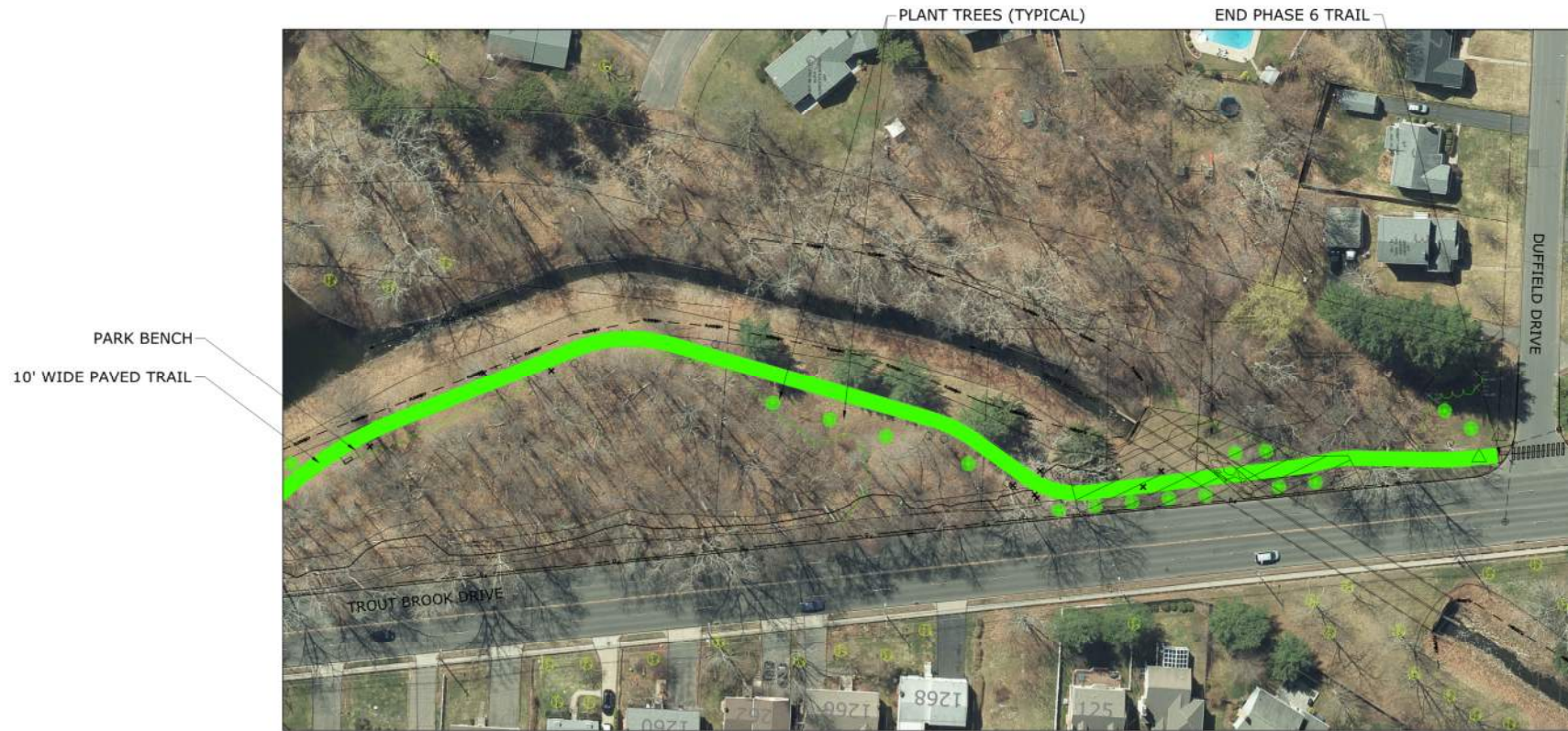

# Trout Brook Trail

## Construction Schedule

Work begins on or about April 10

- ↳ Substantial completion anticipated in July (open to public)
- ↳ Final completion work includes tree planting, turf restoration, etc.
- ↳ Construction likely concludes August 2023

Total Construction Cost:	\$1,178,297
Construction Items	\$978,581
Inspection & Contingencies:	\$195,716

Funding: State of Connecticut, 100%
