Please check PowerParent for a complete list of missing assignments, quizzes, & tests related to the failing grade. If you still have questions, please contact your son/daughter's teacher(s).

The ILearn Biology test will be given to students currently in Biology the week of April 17. There will be practice tests given the week of April 10. A parent letter and information flyer from IDOE will be sent via ParentSquare when we return from spring break. Please try to avoid appointments during these testing windows.

Course Verification Sheets, listing student course selections for the 23-24 school year, will be distributed to students in grades 9-11 on Thursday, April 6. All grade 9-11 families (both in-person and virtual) will also receive a copy through ParentSquare. Please look over the courses your student is registered for and if any changes to course requests are desired, use the link sent in ParentSquare. It is vital that these change requests are made by the April 21 deadline to help us make final scheduling and staffing decisions. Spring break is March 20-March 31.

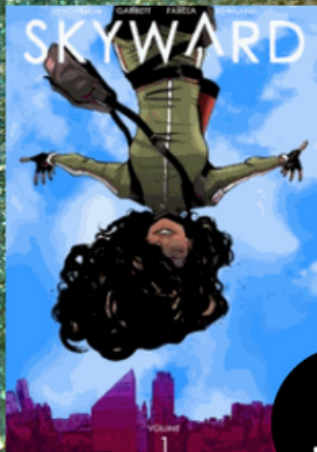
