This guiding document, [Blueprint 2025](#), is provided as a high-level overview of the district's plan. In addition, we have provided a breakdown of strategies by goal.

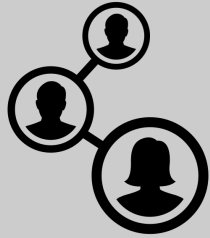
