



VISUAL ART




much of his heart and soul he has gifted to this campus.

nities -- Changemaker Challenge, a nationwide contest that gives young leaders an opportunity to take their innovative ideas for creating a more inclusive, equitable and sustainable future to the next level.

Current 10th & 11th graders -- **Aeronautical Science Pathway**

(ASP) is a FREE program for students who want to become professional pilots or work in drone operations, air traffic control, airport management, airline dispatch, or any other aviation operations management fields.

PAID: Student Trainee

(Partnership in Education Intern) (due 3/25) -- Students gain experience in an internship with the Federal Trade Commission in Seattle.

PAID: <u>Fred Hutch Cancer Research Center</u> (due 3/31) -

- The Summer High School Internship Program (SHIP) is a competitive, eightweek, full-time paid internship for rising 12th graders. The program is specifically designed for students from backgrounds underrepresented in biomedical science.



Accounting Career Aware-

ness Program (due 4/1) ---

If you are interested in accounting and business, enrolled in high school in Washington, and will be a sophomore, junior or senior next year, Seattle ACAP's summer Residency Week program is for you! Applicants must be students of color, with priority given to those that are considered underrepresented in the accounting field: African American/Black, Hispanic/Latinx, and Native American.

<u>Seattle Children's Research Institute: Summer Internship</u> (due 4/2) --- Students will learn how to work in a research laboratory environment and learn about topics including biochemistry, immunotherapy, gene editing and infectious diseases. Students will also participate in workshops on college readiness and career exploration. These programs provide students with a solid foundation for a future career in biomedical research. There is no cost to participate.

- <u>UW Nurse Camp</u> (due 4/15) -- This is a **free week-long camp** geared towards increasing access and opportunities in nursing to a more diverse population of high school sophomores and juniors who are at least 16 years of age by the first day of camp. (Essay and Recommendation required)
- **PAID:** RadioActive Radio Journalism Internship (due 5/9) --- RadioActive is a fun, challenging, and hands-on summer workshop, teens get paid to learn radio journalism and storytelling skills, build confidence, and work with others while producing a true radio story and podcast episode.
- <u>Na-Ha-Shnee Native American Health Summer Internship</u> --- two-week summer camp at Washington State University Spokane for Native students. The program encourages youth to try out a career in the health sciences by providing hands-on learning experiences taught by healthcare providers, faculty at WSU Spokane, and health sciences college students.




- Red-Tailed Hawk Summer Program (due 7/8) --- RTH Aviation Day Camp is a hands-on exposure to the world of aviation held at Boeing Field each fourth Saturday in July. We introduce underrepresented students in the Puget Sound area to the world of aviation. We provide them with basic pilot knowledge, provide hands-on STEM experiences, teach aviation history, and provide discovery flights in general aviation aircraft.
- <u>Girls Who Code</u> --- Girls & Non-Binary students gain the computer science skills they need to make an impact and prepare for tech careers in our free, virtual summer programs. Summer program participants get exposure to tech jobs, meet leaders in tech careers, and find community in our supportive sisterhood; all while investing in their future self.
- PAID: <u>Microsoft Discovery Internship</u> --- Discoverers will participate in a curriculum designed to introduce core computer science concepts, develop career readiness skills, gain mentorship with Microsoft employees, while gaining hands on project expeirence. Discover how your passions and interest in technology/STEM can evolve into a career in tech at Microsoft and beyond. This paid, 4-week summer program offers an exciting opportunity to get valuable experience prior to starting college. Learn more about the Discovery Program.
- <u>Stanford University Qualia Global Scholars</u> -- A pre-college virtual summer program for students to gain Stanford mentors. (cost to attend)


