

Edgenuity 40-40-20

Beginning in the 2019-20 school year, FCAO Edgenuity classes will be weighted as follows:

- **40% Actual Grade at end of first quarter**
- **40% Relative Grade at end of the semester**
- **20% Final**

This is a change from previous years and is more closely aligned to how the in-school classes are weighted.

The classes are still self-paced, but just within the 9-weeks. If you are behind in your progress, that will be reflected in the actual grade. Your actual grade at the end of the first quarter now represents 40% of your overall course grade. **Do not fall behind.**

In Edgenuity, you will see two classes: the course itself and the final exam. The final exam will remain locked until the teacher unlocks it for you to take. You must take the final exam, as it represents 20% of your course grade.

Note: If you are behind at the end of the first quarter, you still must complete all of the work to progress in the class. Completing those late assignments won't affect your Q1 grade, your Q1 grade will remain the *Actual Grade* you had on the last day of the first quarter.
