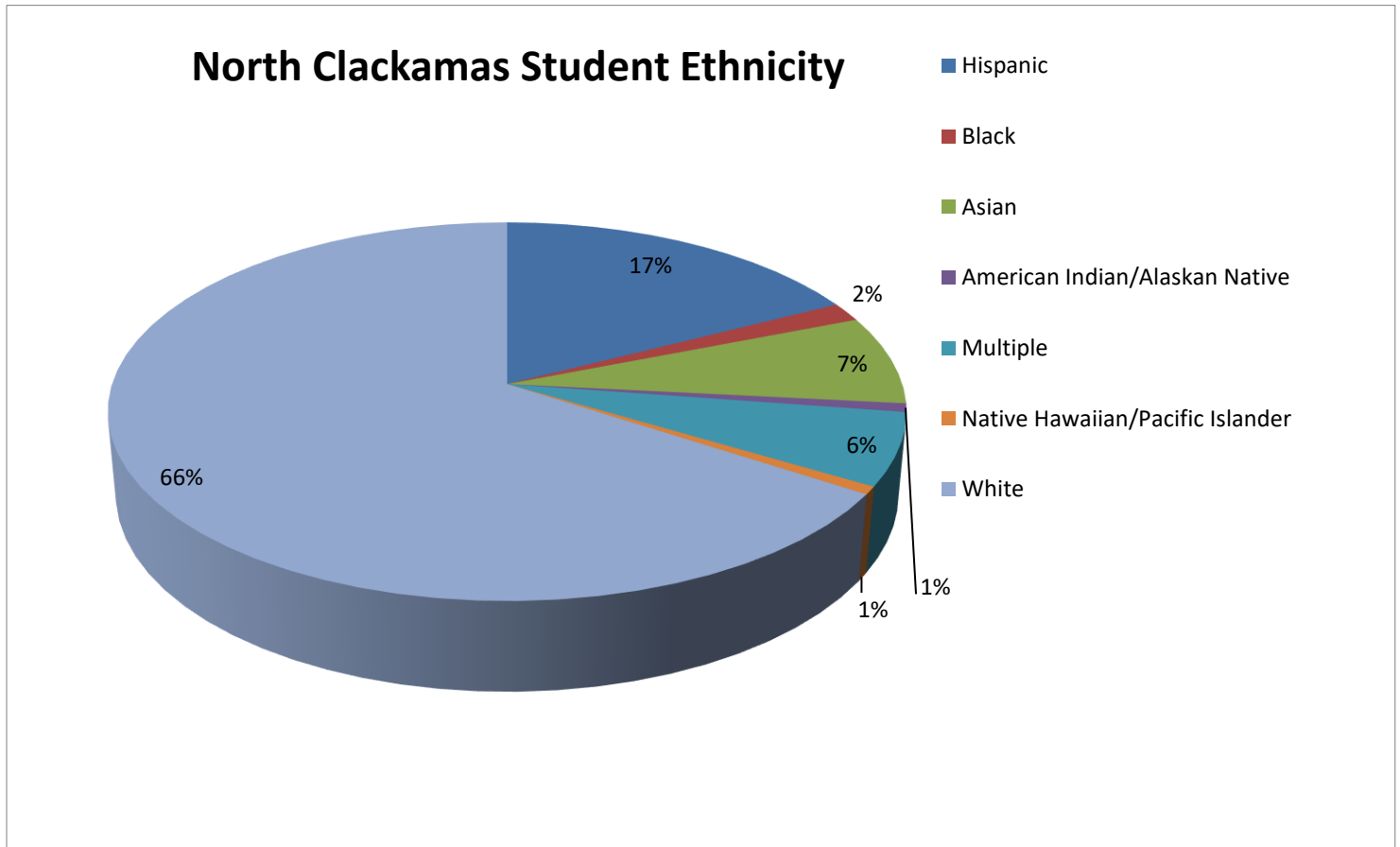


Section IA. District Demographics

The North Clackamas School District per spring membership serves over 17,000 students in 18 Elementary Schools (including three magnet programs), four Middle Schools (including one magnet program), four High Schools (plus two high school choice options), one Career-Technical School, and three Charter Schools. Below is a pie chart showing the largest ethnicity groups for the 2014-2015 school year.

Overall, 1,499 students are designated as English Learners. Although the overall district percentage of EL students is approximately 8.8%, there is a range in individual school populations from 3.2%– 41%.
