Current plan is to schedule this project to begin mid May or June with timeline to complete approximate 2-3 weeks.

Career and Technology Renovation

Pre-Demolition-

November 17th- Teaching materials and shop supplies moved into connex boxes for storage.

December 5th- SISD/Lemon's Auction of surplus materials not to be use in new facility.

Demolition-

Began on Jan 6th- Walls down and majority of materials removed Jan 17th

Relocation of Dual Credit Welding Program-

SISD Leased blue "Norrell" Building on Main Street.

Welding Program begins classes in new location Jan 21st.

Work has been on going at the CTE Building since Jan 06. We had a tour of the facility on Feb 25 with Bond Oversight Committee Chair, Vice Chair as well as the SISD Board Members who serve on the committee just to bring them up to date on the progress.

Many milestones have been achieved with all segments of the project moving forward and on time.

- Currently we are basically in the "finishes" stages with floor treatments and ceiling tile replacement pending.
- MEP work is nearing completion and all plumbing is completed outside of fixtures and tilework.
- Electrical is wrapping up with data wiring going in now.
- CMU work is wrapping up and window and door frames are being completed.
- Exterior work still pending such as to the new front entrance where there will be the new "storefront" with awning and entry to be completed as well as the new facade added to the front the building.
- The outdoor learning space Avadek as well as fencing is awaiting installation.
- All furniture and equipment is ordered or ready to be ordered.
- Things have progressed nicely and we are certainly pleased with the work on this project.

There has been a tremendous amount of work accomplished as well as some critical planning and staging for the overall beginning of the work scheduled.

- Nearly all external work: site work, air handler pads and placement, saw cutting and pour back of new primary electrical service, fire water supply lines have all been completed.
- Firewater riser-rooms are well on their way with the new electrical switch gear scheduled for installation possible in the next 2 weeks.
- We have adjusted key tasks such as the remaining asbestos abatement work, teacher packing and boxing up, and the scheduled online auction for classroom furniture which will be replaced.
- As we now know, school will not meet back on campus for this school year and this
 has allowed our construction schedule to begin sooner than we had first anticipated.
- Currently the JH High school library has been boxed and moved and all technology, computer labs and teacher stations have also be secured and moved into storage in the JH girl's gym.
- All teachers have boxed their supplies and Monday morning we are scheduled to begin moving those boxes into storage also.

We had and equally aggressive schedule of work for Spring Break at the Elem campus and it centered on the completion of as many external projects and tasks as we could complete in that 1 week turn around. Here again, with the uncertainty of COVID-19 we found ourselves wanting to move forward but were very cautious with the social distancing and the question of when will we come back to school and etc.

- Preliminary work did move forward, such has removing data access points, disconnecting sinks scheduled for removal, as well as some initial electrical planning and investigation.
- Now we have the Governors decision about closing campuses so as of today, 90+ % of the teachers have boxed and move all of their personal belongings.
- The moving of the library and computer labs, along with teacher computer work stations began yesterday and is expected to be completed by Friday.
- On Monday we will begin moving furniture to prepare for our online auction. Our goal is to sell as much of the Elem furniture as possible and have it removed from the building by the end of May.
- All furniture will be moved to the Elem gym for the auction in order to not hold up construction in the classrooms.

















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
