Eligible Teachers & Phase-in

Ultimately, RISD envisions every teacher to be eligible for TIA funding; however, it does not currently have growth measures in all grades and subjects. The following phased-in approach provides RISD time to develop growth measures in other subject areas and to pilot them to ensure validity and reliability.

Phase 1: Teachers of courses with growth measures currently in place

- K-8th Reading & Math
- Pre-K
- 5th & 8th Science
- 8th Social Studies

Phase 2: All teachers

- HS EOC Courses
- AP Courses
- Special Education
- Intervention
