

The CIS Committee met on Monday, October 16 at 6:00 p.m. to review the “draft” recommendation on how to proceed with the current CIS building. The following changes were suggested to the document:

- Correct the spelling of Mike Madachik’s last name;
- Change “at” to “with” in second paragraph on page 2 (the district is locked in with...);
- Change the word “historical” to “community” wherever it is listed in the document;
- Insert “that” in the last paragraph on page 2 (Rather, it is understood that...);
- Reference Ohio Revised Code in the fourth bullet on page 3;
- Add the word “permanently” in the fourth bullet on page 3;
- Add the preservation of OJ Work Auditorium as a priority in the areas referencing preservation of the current building in some capacity;
- Add liability in the fourth bullet on page 3;
- Change “will need” to “should consider” on page 3;
- Eliminate “and, purchase the property” in the middle of page 3; and
- Under the “should consider” section on page 3, add a bullet point about creating a process that allows for large-scale community input on the recommendation.

Andy will send out to committee members the revised “draft,” reflecting the changes listed above. If further language changes are needed (tweaks to the changes above), Andy will revise according to the feedback received. Michael Foore and Michelle Boni will present the committee’s recommendation to the board of education on Monday, November 20, 2017. The board of education meeting will be held in the James R. McIlvaine Performing Arts Center at Wadsworth High School and starts at 7:00 p.m. Committee members are encouraged to attend the meeting if their schedule allows.

Andy shared that once the recommendation is made to the board of education, he would imagine that the board of education will engage the committee in some way as they move forward with considering the recommendation. If another committee meeting is needed, Andy will contact members to schedule one.
