2200 Board Powers

2203 Authority to Establish Curriculum

The phrase "State curriculum content standards," as used in this Policy, means the State Board's recommended model curriculum content standards developed and periodically updated under the Revised School Code.

- A. The Board will ensure that legal requirements, including Revised School Code Sections 1278 (core academic curriculum) and 1280 (accreditation), are met for any consortium program in which the District participates.
- B. The Superintendent or designee, after consulting with teachers and District administrators, and after considering the State curriculum content standards, will recommend for Board approval a core academic curriculum for any consortium program operated by the District.
- C. The Superintendent or designee will ensure that the core academic curriculum for any consortium program operated by the District is reviewed periodically for legal compliance and as required by Policy 5420.
