



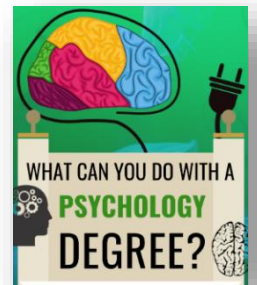

Y10 – Y13 Speakers' Club – Careers in Psychology – 28 March, 1.30pm

I am frequently asked 'what career can I go in to if I study Psychology?' Come along to our next Speakers' Club, hosted by the University of Law, to find out. We'll hear about the different types of careers available with a psychology degree, with a particular focus on those across the criminal justice system. We will also look at different progression routes and how the transferable skills developed from psychology can support your ambitions.



Yr 11 – Y13 Field based conservation courses



Operation Wallacea are running wildlife conservation courses at the Knepp Estate in West Sussex – Britain's premier rewilding site. It is a fantastic opportunity for biology and geography students to gain some field experience (1 or 2 weeks) which will give you a head start into careers in UK conservation as well as building a



great skill set. You'll be taught the foundations of the R statistical package and learn techniques for surveying a range of different flora and fauna. You'll meet professional scientists, field biologists, film makers etc that have made careers in wildlife conservation or climate change, to give you an idea of career opportunities available. It also counts as the residential part of the Gold Duke of Edinburgh award.

To find out more, join the seminar on the 28th of March. Opwal's lead entomologist will be discussing the importance of rewilding in the UK, biodiversity uplift and the use of private sector funding to support this, and how the field courses have been developed to help participants be prepared for the anticipated explosive growth in career opportunities within wildlife management and climate change careers in the UK.

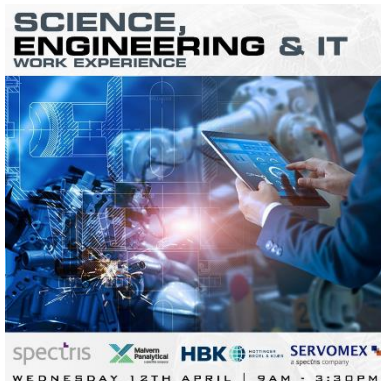
