ELOP

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What is ELOP?

Expanded day for students in TK-6th grades to up to 9 hours of programming during the school year and up to 30 days of summer programs. The after school expanded day is *optional*.



Learning including supplemental lessons that supports academics, social emotional learning, and enrichment.

Opportunity options include areas of enrichment like art, STEM, physical fitness/sports, dance, language, and more.

Programming for ELO is funded by Ed Code 46120 which establishes that all LEAs offer all unduplicated students access to after school and intersessional learning opportunities.



ELOP After School Program Details

- ❖ **Optional enrollment** for all students in TK-6 with opportunities to participate at no cost *based on eligibility*
- ❖ **ELOP Sites:**
 - Cloverly
 - Emperor
 - La Rosa
 - Longden
- ❖ **Capacity:** Up to 60 students per site
 - Class size: 1:10 for TK and 1:20 for K-6
- ❖ **Hours of Operation:**
 - Daily from dismissal until 6:00pm



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ELOP Program Components for TK-6

- ❖ **Academic support** for diverse learners to meet grade level standards
- ❖ **Enrichment programs** in art, physical fitness, and STEM
- ❖ **Social Emotional Support** for students that focuses on well-being, emotion management, and behavioral supports
- ❖ **Nutrition** that supports the dietary needs of students

★ Intersessional ELOP Summer Programs ★

- ❖ Hosted at Longden Elementary
- ❖ Program dates will align with elementary summer school dates
- ❖ All students are eligible to participate, however space is limited
- ❖ Some students will be eligible to participate at no cost, based on eligibility criteria
- ❖ Excursionary Learning (field trips) will be an additional component of the Summer ELOP Program
