The Board may, in its sole discretion and consistent with Revised School Code Section 632 and any applicable collective bargaining agreement, approve a Professional Staff member's paid or unpaid leave of absence for the purposes of pursuing professional improvement (i.e., a sabbatical) or any other similar circumstance. A Professional Staff member seeking a leave of absence must apply in writing to the Superintendent for presentation to the Board at least 60 days in advance. The leave of absence will be consistent with any applicable collective bargaining agreement or individual employment contract. If approved, the Board will negotiate a letter of agreement with the appropriate bargaining unit to approve a Professional Staff member's paid or unpaid leave of absence for the purposes of pursuing professional member's paid or unpaid leave of absence to a professional Staff member's paid or unpaid leave of absence will be contract.
