

## Format for Senior Capstone Project Proposal 2022

**This page includes assignment directions and how to format your proposal.**

1. Preliminary research needs to be completed before you write your proposal.
2. You should have notes on the sources that you have looked at..
3. For your first advisor meeting, create a working **draft** of your proposal.
4. The proposal must be **TYPED** using the format below.
5. First meeting with your advisor should be no later than **Thursday, April 14, 2022**. Bring your working draft proposal and any notes.
6. The corrections to that your first draft should be brought to a second discussion with your advisor, no later than **Friday, April 29**.
7. Your final typed **formal** proposal must be signed by your advisor and submitted to the capstone coordinator no later than **4:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 5, 2022**.

Set up your typed research project proposal in the following format:
