
At this time in our history, we have record enrollment, academic and athletic successes, outstanding musical productions, service learning impact, and exciting opportunities to expand our campus through capital-building projects. Over the past ten years, we have completed multiple capital improvements totaling nine million dollars while acquiring minimal new debt. As part of our strategic plan, we have begun the construction of our 21,000 sq. ft. Performing Arts Center and the planning of our expansion of Roland Dining Hall. The Performing Arts Center will provide additional classrooms, office spaces, and an auditorium for not only musical and theatrical performances, but also for weekly Chapel programs.

Our current Dining Hall space was built in 1962 when our enrollment was 176 students. Presently, we serve 1200+ students, staff, and faculty daily. Our plans will include expanding the dining hall, renovating and updating the kitchen facilities, and enhancing the dining experience.

With these new projects, we have a need to raise six million dollars through our *Built to Last* Capital Campaign 2023. We commit to continue our practice of effective financial management for expansion and improvement. During the renovation of this space, we replaced the outdated rubber floor with a new Prater Flooring designed wood surface. We added retractable bleachers to the North side of the gym, refurbished the walls, and resurfaced the interior roof.

S.O.A.R. CENTER | \$115K

The academic support program was enhanced with the addition of a dedicated space that features multiple individual instructional rooms, small group meeting rooms, and an additional testing area.



WHITEHAVEN HOME PURCHASES/CAMPUS EXPANSION | \$1.4M

We purchased six additional homes that surround our campus which has allowed us to create new instructional spaces, a dedicated maintenance department, and office spaces.


