



# What is at risk for our students?

If the operational referendum fails on April 4<sup>th</sup>, many changes will need to be made. Unfortunately, these changes will affect our students, staff, and community.

Currently the District is looking at the following reductions for the 2023-24 school year:

- Eliminate full time substitute position
  - Eliminate kindergarten paraprofessional position
  - Eliminate one food service position
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Below is an outline of other potential reductions:

## **District Sponsored Co-Curricular and Athletics:**

- Eliminate all middle and high school non-instructional funded clubs and activities
  - Future Farmers of America, Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, Future Business Leaders of America, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, National Honor Society, Student Council, Spanish Club, Varsity Club, Drama, Forensics, Science Olympiad
- Eliminate school funded field trips
- Eliminate middle school athletics
- Eliminate paid elementary athletics positions
- Initiate a "pay to play" high school athletic fee
- Reinstate admission fees for all events

## **District Administrative, Teaching and Support Staff:**

- Eliminate one administrative position
- Reduce co-athletic director to one position
- Reduce elementary and middle school grades to one section based on student enrollment
- Reduce elementary non-state required specials (i.e. computers and library)
- Reduce middle and high school elective courses based on student enrollments
  - Agriculture, Technology Education, Art, Spanish, Business, Family Consumer Education, Music, and Physical Education
- Eliminate/Reduce non-instructional staff positions
  - For example: Clerical, instructional technology, regular education aides, playground supervisor, custodial position

## **Other District Cuts:**

- Defer facility maintenance and repairs
  - Roof, boilers and heating infrastructure
- Eliminate individual computers for students
