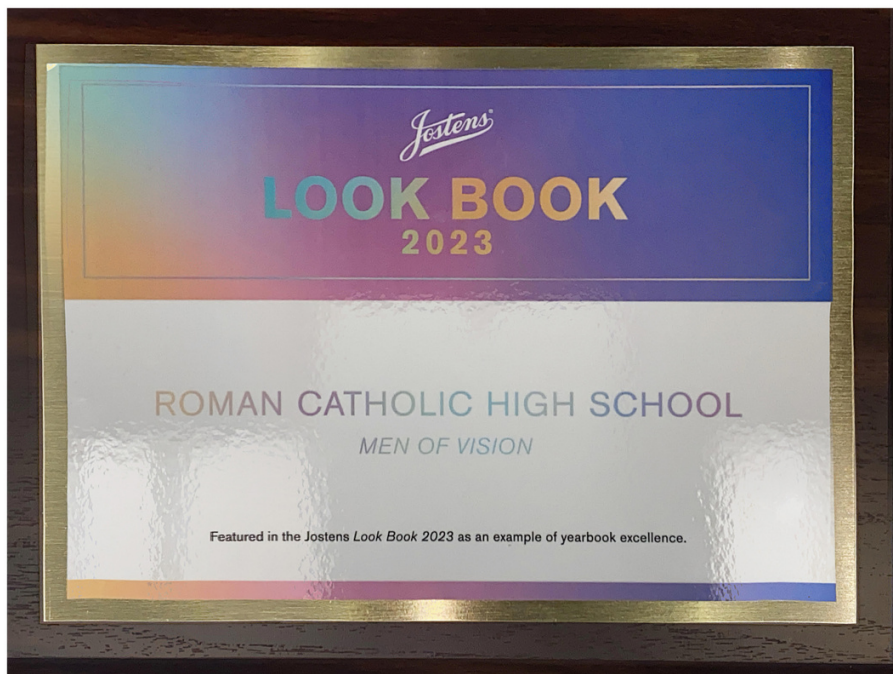

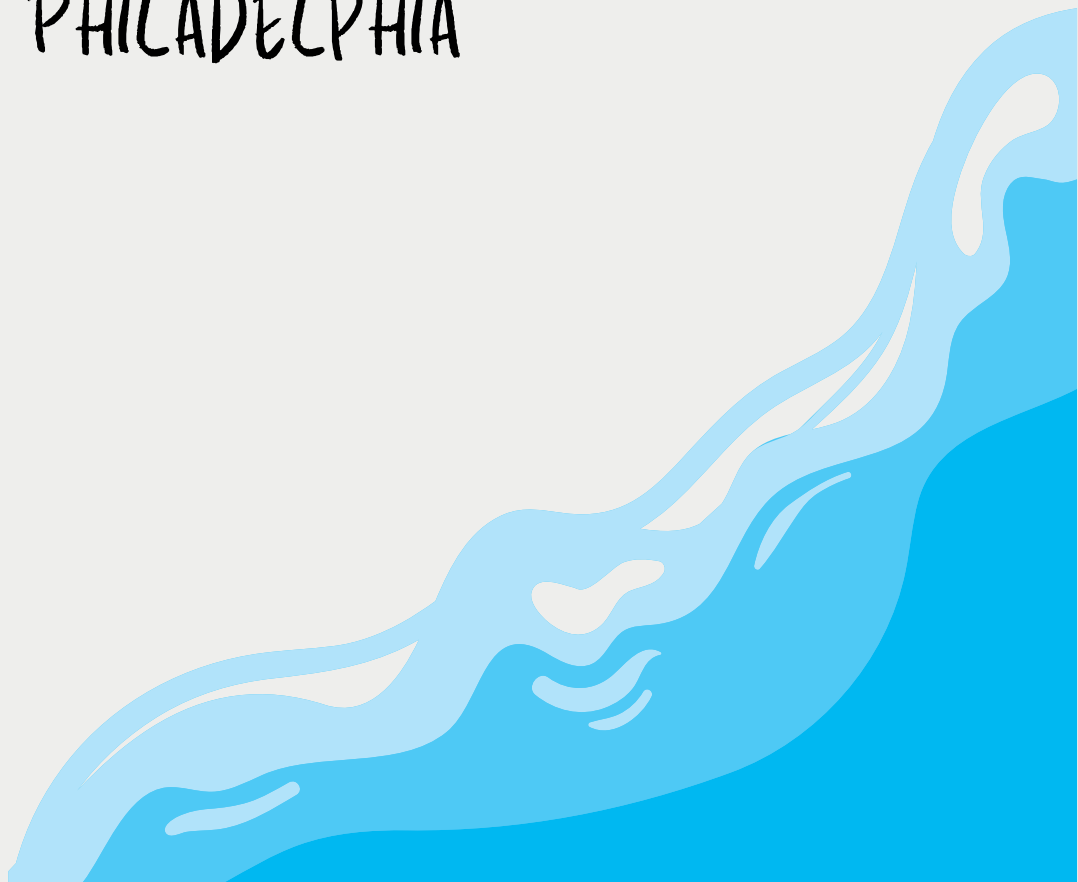

1. Positions start at \$16

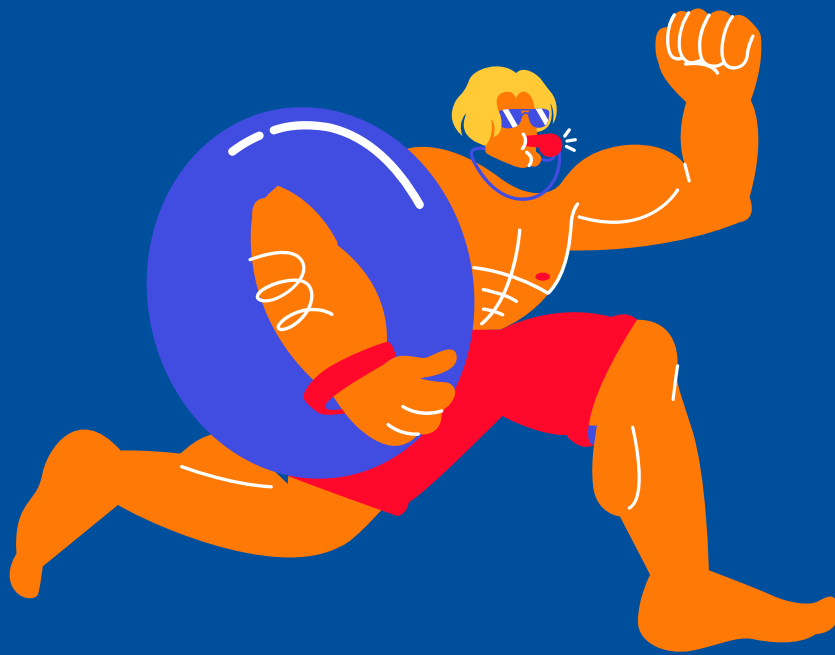
2. Ages 16 and up
