### Layna Kemp is named 2023-2024 Teacher of the Year

Kemp is a 2nd-grade teacher of all subjects at Long Cane Elementary School. Dr. Brian Shumate, Superintendent of TCSS, announced Kemp as the system TOTY during a reception at the Del'avant Event Center Wednesday evening.

Kemp is a graduate of Point University with a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education. She also has a Masters in Curriculum and Instruction from LaGrange College. Kemp has been a teacher at LCES since 2015.

A panel of judges reads and scores the finalists' essays and applications, including a taped interview and classroom observation showing them teaching a lesson through a 20-minute recorded video. This year, we had four judges, anonymous to each other, to decide our Teacher of the Year. The judges who are at various levels in their educational career are all outside of the Troup County School System.

In addition to being named the TCSS Teacher of the Year, if she chooses, Layna Kemp will represent the Troup County School System in the State Teacher of the Year competition sponsored by the Georgia Department of Education.
