

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY Equal Educational Opportunity ADM-A009

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- 1. Equal educational opportunity and treatment shall be provided to all students.
- 2. All students, regardless of age, disability, national origin, race, color, marital status, religion, gender, sexual orientation or financial ability shall have the right to fair, equal, and impartial education and the right to equal access to course offerings and opportunities in all aspects of the school curriculum, activities, and services.
- 3. No student enrolled in the District be excluded from, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination in a District educational program, activity, or service.
- 4. District staff shall make every effort to eliminate conditions within the school environment which may cause discrimination.
- 5. The District shall review and, as necessary, modify course catalogs and policies to assure equal access to courses for all students.
- 6. The District shall provide appropriate instruction to a student for whom English is a second language.
- 7. The District shall ensure that, as far as is consistent within the school setting, each student receives an education without curtailing the expression of his/her cultural, ethnic, racial and/or religious background.
- 8. The Superintendent will designate at least one employee to coordinate its efforts to comply with and carry out its responsibilities under <u>Title IX</u>. See Policy *HUM-A036, Title IX*, for additional information.
