This is Principal Allen with your weekly Panther update.

I hope you enjoyed your weekend. We look forward to you joining us for our Parent Teacher Conference on Tuesday evening, March 28th, from 4:00 - 6:00 pm to pick up your student report card and meet with the teachers. Students must pass 75% (3 out of 4) classes to be eligible for athletes and keep their driver's licenses.

To be promoted, 9th graders need 6 credits, including English I; 10th graders need 12 credits, including English 2; 11th graders need 20 credits, including English III; and our seniors need 28 credits, including English IV, to graduate in June. Please monitor your student's grades on Parent Portal and help us encourage them to do their best at school every day.

When you visit on Tuesday evening, please bring baby diapers, baby wipes, or dog/cat food for our community service project. Help us support Families Living Violence Free and Granville County Animal Shelter.

It is registration season at GCHS. Please ensure you have reviewed your students' registration sheet and signed the back of the form. Our school counselors will finish meeting with homerooms this week.

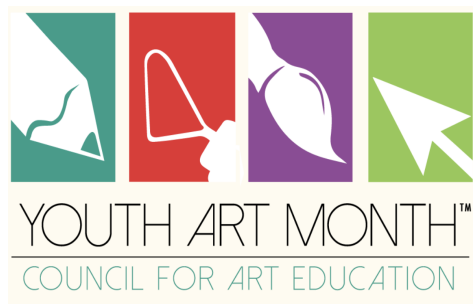

Esperamos que nos acompañe en nuestra conferencia de padres y maestros el martes 28 de marzo por la noche, de 4:00 p. m. a 6:00 p. m. para recoger la boleta de calificaciones de su estudiante y reunirse con los maestros. Los estudiantes deben pasar el 75% (3 de 4) clases para ser elegibles como atletas y mantener sus licencias de conducir. Para ser promovido, los estudiantes de 9° grado necesitan 6 créditos, incluyendo Inglés I; los estudiantes de 10° grado necesitan 12 créditos, incluyendo Inglés 2; los estudiantes de 11° grado necesitan 20 créditos, incluido Inglés III; y nuestros seniors necesitan 28 créditos, incluyendo Inglés IV, para graduarse en junio. Por favor, controle las calificaciones de su hijo en el Portal de Padres y ayúdenos a alentarlos a hacer lo mejor que puedan en la escuela todos los días. Cuando visite el martes por la noche, traiga pañales para bebés, toallitas húmedas para bebés o comida para perros/gatos para nuestro proyecto de servicio comunitario. Ayúdenos a apoyar a Families Living Violence Free y al refugio de animales del condado de Granville. Es temporada de inscripciones en GCHS. Asegúrese de haber revisado la hoja de registro de sus estudiantes y de haber firmado el reverso del formulario. Nuestros consejeros escolares terminarán de reunirse con los salones esta semana. Felicitamos a los estudiantes que ingresarán a la Sociedad Nacional de Honor Técnico el jueves 30 de marzo a las 5:30 p. m. en el ala de educación de CTE. 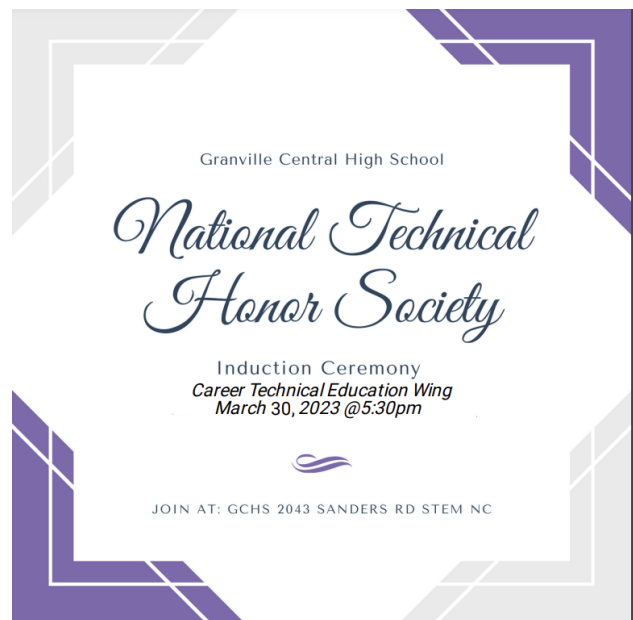
