What metrics are being used to determine if a student is growing? What happens when a student is not growing?

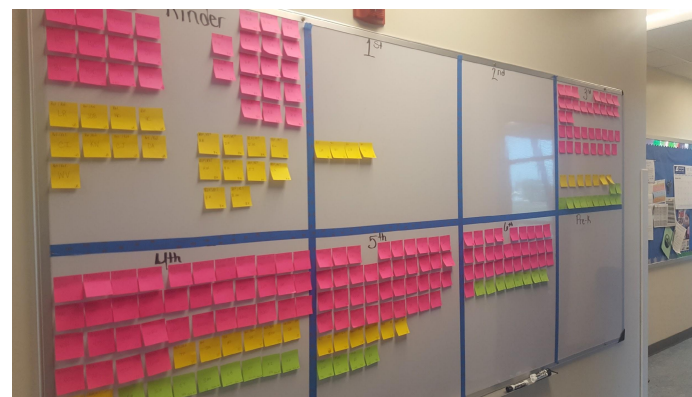
