

MILES OF SMILES AND EXTRA HELP

Funded through Extended School Services

- Are you searching for ideas on how to make better grades?
- Do you need extra help with homework?
- Do you need help with a special project?
- Have you had an extended illness and need some extra time to complete assignments?
- Need to recover lost credits?

In this part of the school program, teachers' extra time and support help students' master material rather than receive failing grades. Help includes peer tutoring, small group instruction, homework support, computer labs, improvement of study skills, and earning lost credits.

This extra assistance doesn't interfere with regular classes. This is not a separate program but is a continuation of the regular class program. This is a free program available to all eligible students. You don't have to be failing a subject or class to be helped by Extended School Services.

These classes offer:

- ✓ smaller class size and more personalized attention,
- ✓ more time for learning important ideas and study skills,
- ✓ teachers who understand the different ways each student learns the best.

Students are not required to attend ESS. If the school staff believes a student needs ESS, parents will be notified. Parent permission is necessary for a student to participate. The notice will provide the times when ESS classes are available. Teachers will provide reports to parents regarding students' progress.

Contact the ESS coordinator in your school or your counselor and ask if ESS would improve your grades.
