NPHS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SENIORS

NPHS Athletic Boosters Scholarship

Criteria:

- Participated in at least one athletic team all four years at NPHS
- Parent membership and significant volunteer service to the Athletic Boosters Club
- Two \$1,500 Awards - one to a male athlete and one to a female athlete with GPA 3.00
- Two \$1000 Awards - one to a male athlete and one to a female athlete with GPA 2.50

NPHS PTSO Scholarship

Criteria: community service, school involvement, minimum GPA 2.50

Award: two awards - \$500 each

NPHS Manufacturing & Engineering Scholarship

Criteria: Must plan to major in one of 17 different manufacturing-related program of studies, school and club involvement, essay

Award: multiple \$1,000 each

Rachel A. Thomas Scholarship

Eligible: Seniors in the NPHS JROTC, Criminal Justice Program, Cheer Team, or Girls Basketball Team

Criteria: Min GPA 2.5, 2 or 4-year college bound, official transcript, 2 letters of recommendation, essay topic provided

Award: 4 awards (one from each group) - \$500 each

Deadline - April 15

BABY SUPPLIES COLLECTION DRIVE

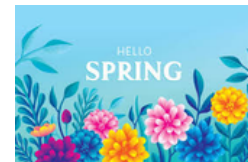
The National Technical Honor will be collecting baby supplies through March 31 to donate to the Children's Aid Society. Donations can be dropped off in room 313. The following items are requested:
