

Clinton Heacock Scholarship

The Clinton Heacock Scholarship, named in honor of the West Branch Local School District's first local superintendent awards **Two (2) - \$1,000** scholarships given by an area industrial firm.

The scholarship is to be awarded to a deserving high school senior in the current graduating class. This scholarship must be applied toward tuition at an accredited college or university. The scholarship may be renewed Three (3) times after the initial awarding, contingent upon maintenance of a **2.50** cumulative grade point average or better (based upon a four-point scale) in the student's major area of preparation. The yearly amount of the scholarship may be progressive in renewals for the third/fourth years. The applicant screening will be completed by the staff of West Branch High School, with the final selection to be made by the awarding company. The criteria to be utilized in that selection are "scholarship, community service and character and leadership." In the event that two candidates have equal qualifications, financial need should be the determining factor. The award will be presented at the "Senior Awards Assembly."

- A short essay on why you need the scholarship
