

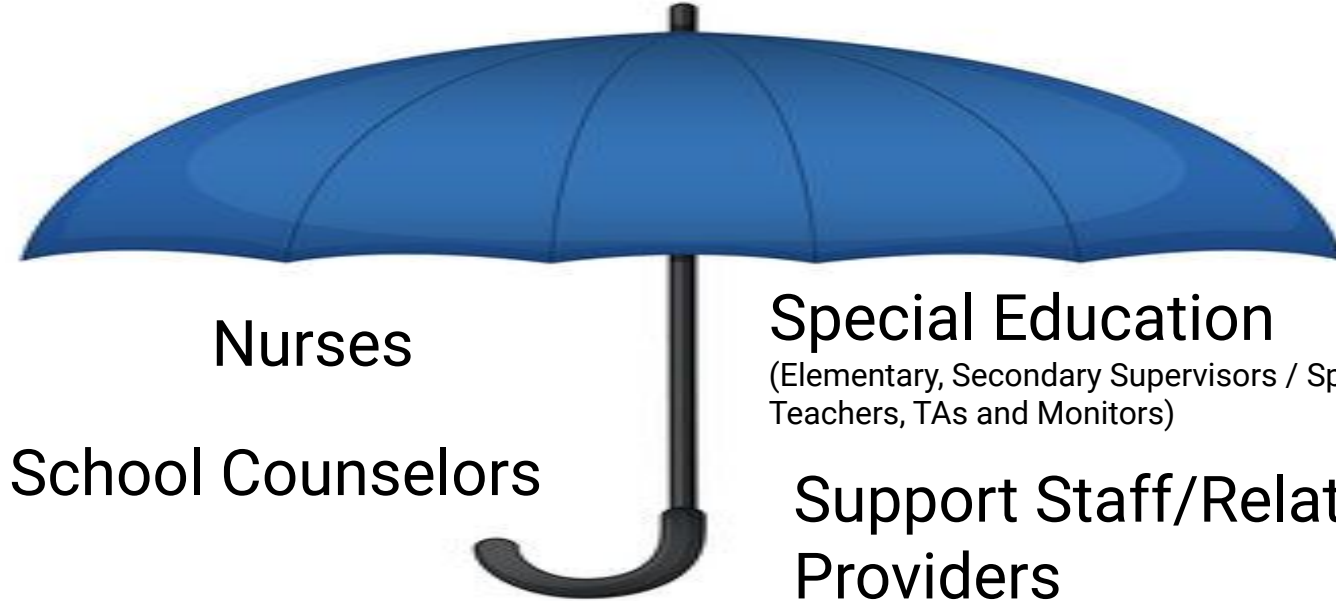

Support Staff- School Psychologists Role

- Conduct psychological assessments/testing
- Required members of the CSE
- Assess diverse learning needs- support struggling and diverse learners
- Provide individual and group counseling per IEP mandates
- Student communication and social skills
- Promote problem solving, managing emotions and develop coping skills
- Collaborate with teachers and school staff in regards to instructional and behavioral classroom strategies
- Collaborate with families and outside mental health providers
- Risk assessments (suicide, self harm)
- Work with building and district level administrators on mental health programming and supports
- Members of MTSS teams



Support Staff- School Social Worker Role

- Integral link between school, home and community
- Provide counseling, individual and group (may be mandated or non-mandated)
- Push in classroom lessons (mindfulness, DBT, bullying, social problem solving)
- School grade level programs
- Attend community network meetings (liaise with community resources- county agencies, food banks, homeless shelters, mental health agencies, social security, OPWDD)
- Collaborate with families and provide case management
- Lunch groups
- Conduct home visits
