

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY Local Wellness FNS-A001

- 1. The Salem-Keizer School Board is committed to providing school environments that promote and protect children's health, well-being, and ability to learn by supporting healthy eating, physical activity and other behaviors that contribute to student wellness.
- 2. The School Board recognizes that while feeding children is primarily the responsibility of the family, the district has a responsibility within the school day to provide students with healthful food options, physical activity and health education programs that promote lifelong well-being.
- 3. Food of minimal nutritional value (FMNV) as defined by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) shall not be sold on school premises.
 - 3.1. Concession stands operated during regularly scheduled athletic or extracurricular events for the purpose of fundraising for the school are exempt.
- 4. Beverages, food and snack items offered in vending machines, a la carte food offerings and student stores must meet guidelines outlined in the District's Local Wellness Procedure FNS-P002.
- The District will establish a Nutrition Wellness Committee comprised of members of the public and staff.
- 6. The School Board will review this policy as needed with input from the District Wellness Committee.
