United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement

INSTRUCTION

- 1. In the event that non-local law enforcement official(s) such as United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), or any other federal law enforcement officials presents themselves at a school, staff shall request and verify identification.
- 2. Absent an arrest warrant, non-local law enforcement officials including ICE officials do not have the authority to remove a student from school.
 - a. If the intent of the visit is to remove a student, staff should immediately contact the superintendent's office for guidance before allowing access to the student.
- 3. Student records shall remain protected under federal law and shall not be shared.
 - a. If the law enforcement official presents a valid search warrant, subpoena, or authorization from the parent or guardian, staff should immediately contact the superintendent's office for guidance before allowing access to records.
- 4. Advise the law enforcement official that you intend to contact the parent/guardian.
 - a. If the officer gives a direct order not to contact the parent, request the authority for such an order and immediately contact the superintendent's office for guidance before contacting the student's parent/guardian or taking any other action
