  - New seating chart during lunch - - helps with contract tracing
- District provided 2 full time substitutes to help cover classes
- WCOBE Meeting held at WCHS - - January 21, 2021 @ 7:00p
- MLK Celebration - - January 16, 2021 (virtual) @ 4:00p.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- Technology Plan
  - Increase the number of chrome books for students/faculty (\$40,465)
  - Perkins monies is also used to obtain technology
  - District is moving to PC
  - The Council approved the 2021-2022 Technology Plan by consensus (Issacs/Lowe)
- 2021 – 2022 School Day Schedule
- 2021 – 2022 Curriculum Guide
  - Embed A/H into another class to better monitor its fidelity

- Credit change due to transitioning to 6-Period Schedule
- Dual Credit Math - - Switch from Campbellsville University to WKU
  - CU doesn't require ACT benchmark
  - CU pays WCHS teachers to teach the class
  - WKU will not accept the CU credit if student did not make benchmark
- Pathway changes
  - Want more attractive pathways
    - Drop Accounting and add Marketing
    - Add School store
    - Add Sports Marketing and Retail Marketing
    - Add Hospitality
    - Drop Agribiotech and add Horticulture - - turf management; landscaping
    - Drop Animal Science
- Health/PE
  - Graduation requirement
  - Move from Freshmen year to Senior year
  - Holds Seniors accountable
- Expectation that students complete a pathway by graduation

- Projected allocations for 2021-2022 coming soon
- 2020-2021 Budget utilized 38.8%




