APPROVAL OF AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

PREVIOUS BUSINESS

- Use Title I to fund an additional 5.53 teaching units for the 2021-2022 school year
 - The Council approved the use of Title I to fund an additional 5.53 teaching units for the 2021-2022 school year by consensus.

NEW BUSINESS

- 2021 Summer School Plan – *Colton Issacs*
 - This Plan is due to high number of failures due to the COVID pandemic - ~190 students.
 - End of May for 3 days
 - Lighthouse Academy
 - June 16 - June 30
 - Core classes only
 - Need 5 teachers and 2 busses per day
 - The Council approved the 2021 Summer School Plan by consensus.

 - Tutoring Sessions
 - The Council approved the Aspiring Young Adults Club proposal for its "first reading" by consensus.

 - George Fant Dream Big Camp – June 18th – June 19th - - **ADMISSION: Free**

- **Graduation - - May 22 @ 3:30 Diddle Arena**

- **Prom - - May 1**

FINANCE

- **ESSER Funding – used to supplement costs incurred due to the pandemic**
 - Round 1 - \$3.5 million - - PPE, air purifiers, wipes, etc. in addition to our 3 long term subs
 - Round 2 – \$13.5 million - - Wish List – Can't purchase technology; want 4th guidance counselor. We received \$91,000.
 - Round 3 - \$36 million
- **Title I Projections – Carryover and 2021/2022 Allocation**
 - \$115,000 carryover
 - Minimum for next year \$417,000 *(Based upon the # students on F/R Lunch)*
- **SBDM Allocation – Receive in May**
 - Should have a substantial carryover




