Rich Todd: Safety Presentation

District was awarded \$486,212 grant

- Public safety radio reception



- District radio communications
- Wayfinding Signage
 - access for everyone to know where they are at the schools in case of emergency
 - anticipate installation by December 2021
- Car reader installations
- Video Surveillance Surveys
- District Emergency Channel
 - base station installed at York County Public Communications Center (911 center)
- Each year, FMSD provides a School Safety Leadership Forum
 - training with bomb threats, drug trends, human trafficking, communicating with 911, EMS, and school shootings
- Safe Schools, Monthly Newsletters, School Safety Advisory Committee, discussion and response scenarios
 - Principals can request in person training for their schools
- safety and emergency services can provide different styles of trainings to review safety measures
- Safety and Emergency Services presented in June 2022, asked to come back in Columbia next week (October 2022)
- Student Initiative in Feb 2023
 - high school students
 - student perspective and involvement with school safety
