The Federal *Every Student Succeeds Act* of 2015 requires school districts that receive federal Title funding to notify parents of their right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers and paraprofessionals, if applicable, who instruct their child.

As a recipient of these funds, Hardin County Schools will provide you with this information in a timely manner if you request it. Specifically, you have the right to request the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers.

- Whether the teacher meets the state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or provisional status because of special circumstances.
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- Whether paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications.

Hardin County Schools is committed to providing quality instruction for all students and does so by employing the most qualified individuals to teach and support each student in the classroom. If you would like to receive any of the information listed above for your child's teacher, please contact the Principal of the school your child attends.
