Flu Vaccinations

PEIP covers flu vaccinations under the preventive benefit at 100%. Participants can go to their primary care clinic or network urgent care facilities for flu shots. Members can also check with their carrier for additional network convenience sites available to PEIP participants.

Tip: Smoking cessation drugs are covered with a prescription from a physician. All FDA-approved medications prescribed for tobacco cessation have \$0 copay – including drug equivalents such as Zyban, Chantix and Nicoderm CQ.

Palliative Care

Palliative care is enhanced services for members with certain chronic diseases – and provides education and support for patient and caregivers within the gap between home health services and hospice care. Services include:

- Care ordered by physician included in home care plan
- Professional visits to assist with advanced care planning or accompany patient to office visits
- AdvancePractice RN – care evaluation/modification
- Home health aide and respite care services
- Pediatric/adolescent anticipatory grief counseling
- Bereavement program services
