



Education Articulation Agreement

Ohio Technical College (OTC) hereby recognizes Eastern Center for Arts & Technology and its Career Technical Education Programs for Articulation. The Agreement provides the details of the partnership.

Articulation Objectives:

Ohio Technical College values the ambition and experience of students who have taken at least one year of skilled – trade classes in high school. A strong foundation of knowledge helps students excel when they continue their education at the college level. Scholarship awards will be distributed evenly each semester of the student’s entire program. Scholarships can only be applied to tuition of a 12-month program or longer.

Process for Recognition:

- Student must submit one letter of recommendation from the teacher of their qualifying class.
- Student must submit a copy of their high school transcript showing a minimum of 2.5 GPA in qualifying class.
- Students’ transcript must provide acceptable attendance junior and senior year of high school. No more than 10 absences allowed each year to qualify. (Documented medical emergencies will be looked at for consideration)

High School Certified Program

- If a High School Automotive or Diesel Program is an ASE/EF accredited program, for every year a student attends that student will receive a \$1000 scholarship. (2-year maximum attendance for program)
- If a High School Auto Body or Collision program is an EF/ASE certified program, for every year a student attends that student will receive a \$1000 scholarship. (2-year maximum attendance for program)
- If a High School Welding program is an AWS/NCCER certified program, for every year a student attends that student will receive a \$1000 scholarship. (2-year maximum attendance for program)

High School Non-Certified Program/Non-Related Program of Study

- All technical programs outside of the programs listed will be considered Non-National certified programs and would fall under this heading.
- If a student completes a minimum of a year in a non-certified program, they will be awarded a onetime scholarship of \$1000. (Must complete one full academic year)

Ohio Technical College reserves the right to modify this program in any way at OTC's sole discretion. This agreement may be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years by the authorized parties with a renewed signed agreement if the authorizing parties need to update the agreement at that time.
