Updates

OCDC open for emergency services starting June 1, Migrant children are being accepted currently.

Grand Ronde- Closed to services, planning to open under limited capacity starting July 6 (max group size 10).

Same children that are in the bus have to be in the classroom, no transportation is being offered at this time for OCDC nor Grand Ronde programs.

WESD update in services- After spring break distance plans were written to serve most of the children. If children in emergency childcare, the IFSP is being implemented at a distance. Focusing in relationships and supporting families where they are.

Evaluations have been challenging, for EI some evals are being done virtually. Currently ~500 evaluations backup, 6 ft distance is needed to meet COVID-19 guidelines and evaluations do not allow for that. Timelines still exist. Evaluation team is talking to parents to see what can be done virtually vs in person.

Children that turned 3 continue being served.

Some families have asked to suspend services, especially in the last few weeks. Jen shared that she has heard feedback that families really have liked this model as they feel the connect more. Equipment- no clearance has been given to provide it, WESD is working on a possible equipment clinic.
