

THIRD GRADE READING LAW

The Michigan Legislature passed a law that requires schools to identify learners who are struggling with reading and writing and to provide additional help. The law states that third graders may repeat third grade if they are more than one grade level behind, and not being proficient on the M-Step.

M-STEP



We have approximately 22 days before Michigan's annual six-week testing season begins in April. M-Step is a high stakes assessment! Attendance, daily instruction, tutoring and intervention will be critical. Let's be focused and ready to take action everyday! The results of the various assessments can influence college admissions, teacher evaluations, and whether third-graders are promoted.






