1. Applicant must be a Sebring Local or West Branch Local Senior
2. Applicant must display characteristics that reflect those that Chief Heverly did, such as honesty, compassion, selflessness, discipline, and resolve
3. Scholarship will be restricted to seniors intending to pursue a career in public services with priority given in the order of Police Officer, Firefighter, Medical Field

Summary / Overview:

1. The Ray Heverly Scholarship Committee will award a one time, non-renewable scholarship to be awarded to one Sebring and one West Branch Senior
2. The selection of the recipients will be made by the scholarship committee and will be announced at the senior awards assembly in the spring

Amount of Scholarship & Presentation of Funds:

1. The scholarship will be in the amount of \$500.00. A certificate of awards will be presented to the recipient at the awards assembly
2. Proof of enrollment and attendance from the recipients College, University, or Trade School will be required before the funds will be disbursed.
