Integrity	Adherence to moral or ethical principles, soundness of moral character.	Do I do the right thing even when no one is watching? Do I conduct myself and make decisions in accordance with the values of district?	
Citizenship	How well a person serves the community in which they live or work.	Do I recognize what a good role model is? Do I serve as a role model for others? Do I serve others in the district and the community? Do I foster positive relationships?	
Honesty	Sincerity, fairness, adherence to facts, straightforwardness. Having the courage to do what is right.	Do I confront issues instead of talking behind peoples' backs? Do I tell the truth even if it is difficult?	
Engagement	Being an active participant and encouraging others to participate.	Am I "in the moment" and not preoccupied with other things? Do I make a contribution or commitment? Do I make a difference? Am I part of the problem or the solution? Am I all in?	
Responsibility	To complete, finish or take care of what is entrusted to us.	Do I hold myself and others accountable? Am I trusted? Do I understand the consequences of what I say and do?
