COVID-19 Info

Participants must have received at least 2 doses of a Government of Canada-accepted COVID-19 vaccine or a mix of 2 accepted vaccines. The Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca / COVISHIELD, and Janssen/Johnson & Johnson vaccines are recognized in Canada for full vaccination status. The vaccines accepted by the Government of Canada for the purpose of travel to and within Canada also includes (1) Bharat Biotech (Covaxin, BBV152 A, B, C), (2) Sinopharm BIBP (BBIBP-CorV), and (3) Sinovac (CoronaVac, PiCoVacc).
